## (MINOR) CRISIS IN INFINITE TITLES

Since Marvel copied the DC initiative of a carte blanche rewrite of all their titles I have been impressed at the overall quality of all their relaunches. To try and appear different Marvel have been rolling out the new #1s across a whole year. Doing this has exposed that Marvel have missed the point of the DC initiative.

DC had tied themselves into knots over the previous decades trying to tidy up their continuity issues starting with Crisis On Infinite Earths, then leading on through Zero Hour, Infinite Crisis, Countdown To Final Crisis and Final Crisis. At the end of Final Crisis things were no clearer than back in 1985 when it all started.

Maybe someone then thought about how John Byrne re-launched Superman back in 1986 with the six issue Man Of Steel mini series which then led into the new on going Superman series in Jan 1987. With no big convoluted explanation he just rewrote Superman's origin and powers.

Fans at first were up in arms as past stories were ignored but soon grew to accept this new revision. In fact revamping of origin and powers has happened several times in Superman's long history. The stories from these previous eras are still valid and enjoyable and still form part of the mythos.

So, DC decided to go the whole hog and change everything. It worked. New fans were brought in and old readers intrigued to step back. The slate is clean and there is some cohesive DC universe.

Back to Marvel. By dragging out relaunches over a full year a wholesale refreshing of the Marvel Universe has



not occurred. In fact as a reader of over half of the Marvel line I find the Marvel Universe a very strange place. There is no coherent time line, no strong editing and we have a Daredevil series, beautiful and with a lighter tone than of years past, but operating totally divorced from all other events in New York and the world.

Check out the Avengers line to see what I mean. Here we have Young Avengers, Avengers Arena, Avengers Assemble, Secret Avengers, Avengers, New Avengers, Uncanny Avengers. Happening in Uncanny we had the Red Skull decimating New York, over in Avengers with no reference to the carnage unfolding in Uncanny, we have the Avengers facing off against the

world breaker. New Avengers are facing off against Galactus in another world impacting event, Avengers Assemble is slightly more down to earth as a psychotic lizard girl attacks Black Widow and Hawkeye, yet more heavy weight action in Secret Avengers and finally Young Avengers who seem to have no idea what is going on in all the other titles! Couple this with the galactic goings on in Guardians of the Galaxy which references the All Mother of the Nine Realms from Thor, but ignores the fact that Thor is locked in a deadly duel with the God Killer which threatens all Gods from all pantheons.

All these stories are excellent, well drawn

and well written, but where is the editorial input to maintain a Marvel Universe that the reader can believe in and feel empathy with?

I obviously read too many titles and expect too much, or do I? I fondly remember the day when while reading one title there would be reference to events in another and the general time lines co-existed. Now it seems there are about a dozen Marvel Universes co-existing side by side and don't get me started on the Age of Ultron which once again I am really enjoying, but whilst it proclaims it will have far reaching effects, I wonder on which universe?

It seems that every Marvel writer is trying to out do the others with their own time line altering, universe changing, cosmos effecting multi-part cross-over. Can't someone else, other than Mark Waid write stories that engage and challenge the reader without mayhem on an industrial scale?

My own feeling is that Marvel have abandoned the writing of comics as an on going soap adventure to hold the readers interest not just for a year but for decades. Now they are all written as a precursor to the inevitable trade collection. This is all very well but they may be losing sight of what made them what they are and what makes comics so endearing and enduring.
